

Subtractive Color- color created through the mixing of physical substances, such as ink, pigments and dyes.

The primary colors of a subtractive color approach are: Red, Yellow and Blue
When these primaries are mixed they create a theoretical black, as shown below.



Additive Color- color created through the mixing of light. Additive color is the system used in the color that is seen on tv, computer and movie screens.

The primary colors of a subtractive color approach are: Red, Green and Blue
When these primaries are mixed they create white, as shown below.
